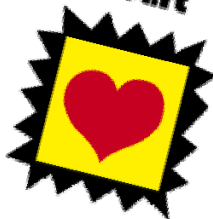

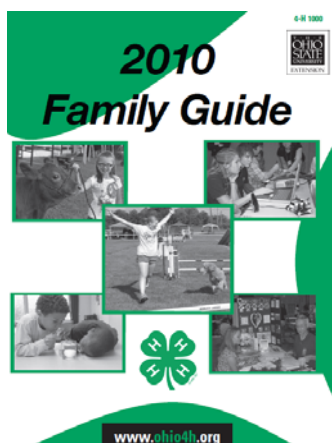

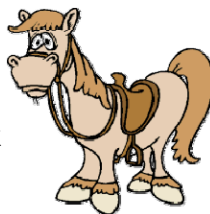


2010 Family Guides

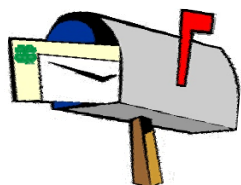

The reports are a participation record of all activities, honors, projects taken, offices held, etc. that the 4-H member has been involved in during their 4-H career. 4-H members of all ages are encouraged to complete the record each year so that when they do reach age 14, all of the information will already be compiled for easy completion. These forms are due no later than 4:30PM at the Franklin County Extension Office on January 15th.

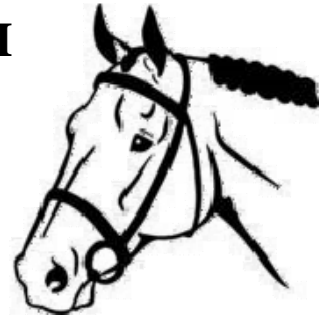


