

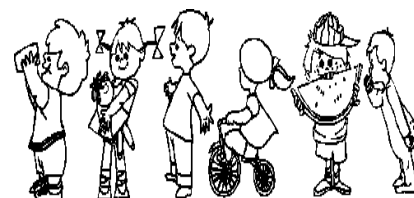
2010 Franklin County Junior Fair Pre-Fair Packet

Evaluation Schedule: The Evaluation Schedule is developed using the number of 4-H members enrolled in a given 4-H project. It is difficult for us to predict what percentage of 4-H members will participate in county evaluations. Please exercise some patience and flexibility when waiting for your judging time. Not everyone can go first and not everyone can be judged at the same time. Our goal is that everyone has a positive and equitable evaluation experience.

Evaluation Check In: Exhibitors should arrive 15 minutes prior to their scheduled project evaluation judging time to complete check-in procedures at the Junior Fair Activities Tent.

Criteria for Judging: The judging/evaluation process will include:

- A. An interview with a judge(s)
- B. Exhibition of a project item(s) and/or educational display
- C. A completed project book; and in some projects skills
- D. Participation in a skills component. Please check the front of your 4-H project book and the *2010 Franklin County 4-H Family Handbook* for details on project judging requirements for each project.
- E. All score sheets for non livestock projects will be distributed at the end of class along with all ribbons.



Required Exhibit Display: After project judging, all exhibitors are required to place their project exhibit in their club booth or the countywide 4-H booth located in the Ganyard Building. Exhibitors who do not comply with this rule will be not be allowed to exhibit in the 2011 Franklin County Junior Fair.

Awards: Recognition will be award based on the evaluation grade of blue, red, or white. State Fair Selection and Alternates or Best of Class, Best of Show and Honorable Mention, where appropriate, will be selected by the judges after all grading has been done for a given class. Only members with a completed project book and an evaluation score of 85 and above will be eligible for the above mentioned awards.

Awards Ceremony: All awards will be presented at the conclusion of the judging event. All members participating in evaluations will have the opportunity to stand on stage, as a class, at the beginning of the awards presentation, to receive recognition for their participation in the day's events.

Exhibit Release Time: All project exhibits must stay on display in their club or countywide 4-H booth until Sunday, July 25. Exhibits must be picked up between 9:00AM and 11:00AM on Sunday, July 25. Any exhibits left after this time will be disposed. Exceptions: Girl Scout and Campfire projects going to the Ohio State Fair (see rules).

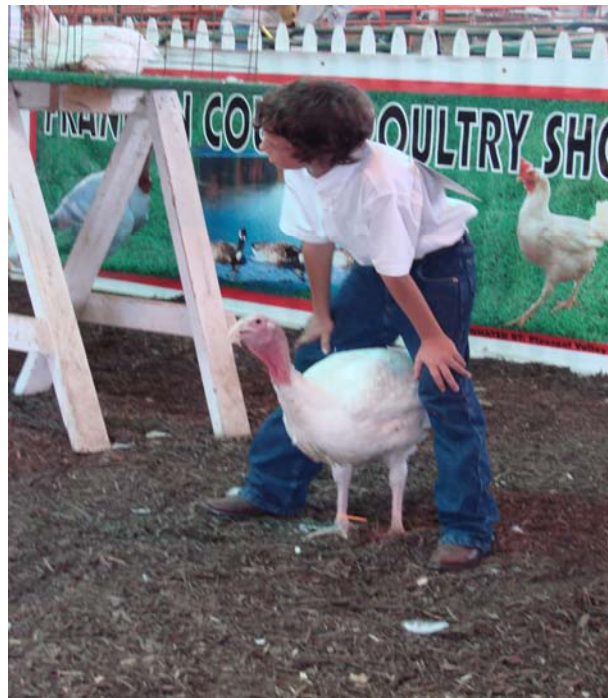

Best Beginning, Intermediate and Advanced Project Book:

Enter these classes on your Junior Fair Entry Form to be eligible to compete. After project evaluation leave your book with a judge to be evaluated on the following: project activities completed, project experiments completed, leadership/citizenship experiences completed, learning experiences completed, project book appearance, legible/neat/well organized, documentation of activities completed (photos, records, recipes) and originality.

All Food and Nutrition Project Members Must Bring the Following To Evaluation:

- Completed food project book with documentation of preparing 75% of all recipes in the project book and 100% of all project activities.
- A prepared food item with recipe related to the 4-H project if different than one of the recipes from the project book. All food items must meet food safety guidelines.
- Educational display resulting from an activity/experiment in the project book (examples: food guide pyramid, cost comparisons, food safety tips, shopping and buying tips, experiment results, etc.). These do not need to be large or elaborate displays. An 8½" x 11" sheet of paper is acceptable.

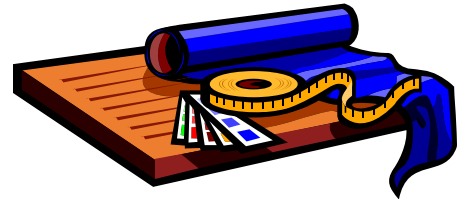
