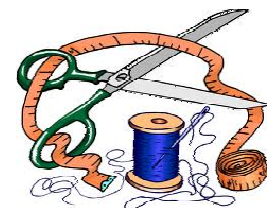
Livestock Skill-a-thon & Evaluations

- Complete clothing outfit with accessories to be modeled and evaluated
- Complete pattern(s) used (all pattern pieces, guide sheets, etc)
- Completed Style Revue Description Form, photograph (head to toe) of outfit on 4-Her and/or, model and a swatch of fabric(s) used to make the outfit for sewn projects

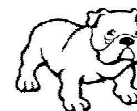

- Be prepared to discuss project book and experiences
- Be prepared to model at the end of each project class
- Be prepared to complete 2 hands-on skills required for specific project (there are 3 listed but the 4-Her will only be asked to complete 2)

**Open to any 4-H member – No county contest for this area. May only enter 1 design.*

**You may participate in the Demonstrations classes at the state fair as well as the Marketing Division.*

Junior Individual – Thank You Card (ages 8-11)

o This should be an original “thank you” card with artwork on the cover and a verse or message inside thanking a business, individual, or others for their support of 4-H

o 8 ½ X 11 inch cardstock – folded once

o May use any medium – crayon, chalk, pen and ink, pencil, markers, etc.

o Can use computer graphics – but they must be original artwork of the member

- Intermediate Individual – 4-H Promotional T-shirt Design (ages 12-13)

o Should be an original t-shirt design with artwork and slogan promoting a county or the 4-H program or some aspect of that program

o Submit design on 8 ½ X 11 inch paper – member’s name, age, and county printed in the lower right-hand corner of the back of the paper

o May use any medium – crayon, chalk, pen and ink, pencil, markers, etc.

o Computer graphics are permitted – must be original work of the member

- Senior Individual – 4-H Infomercial (ages 14 and up)

o This is a video “short” that promotes a county or the state 4-H project or program or some aspect of that project or program - fully automated, stand alone video presentation with sound and narration as appropriate (think Youtube) – should include recorded visual, sound, and narration to convey a message

o 2-4 minutes long

o Must be submitted on a DVD and must play using QuickTime Player or Windows Media Player

o Should be the original work of the member
