Return this form to the OSU Extension Athens County Office, by the Second Wednesday in May. Late registration will not be accepted. Any exhibitor who must change horses after the second Wednesday in May, due to unsoundness or otherwise, WILL NOT be permitted to qualify for state fair.

- C. Medium Pony - over 50" (12-2 hands) but not exceeding 54" (13 -2 hands)**
- D. Small Pony - 50" (12-2 hands) and under**

****Exhibitors may not enter both Low Working Hunter and Regular Working Hunter.**

*****Easy gaited horses may not show in classes in which horses must trot. Correct tack and attire for Easy Gaited Equitation and Easy Gaited Pleasure is Saddleseat or western tack and attire, respectively. Easy gaited classes will be two-gaited classes (no canter). Gaits will be a flat foot walk and a pleasure gait.**
