

2012 Meigs County Junior Fair Prince and Princess Competition

1. Must exhibit a beef, dairy, goat, horse, poultry, rabbit, sheep, or swine project in 4-H or FFA.
2. Must be age 9-15 as of January 1st, 2012.
3. Must not be married nor have been married, nor have borne a child or be with child.
4. Must participate in the Junior Fair Parade, Livestock Shows, Livestock Sale and pictures, and be available for any other livestock activity.
5. Must conduct themselves at all times in a respectable manner.
6. Cannot accept more than one title a year.
7. Can only be Prince and Princess one year per species, unless no one runs the following year.
8. Banner, crown or other official Royalty Attire must be worn at all times unless showing or cleaning animals.
9. The Dairy Prince or Princess must either exhibit dairy at the Meigs County Fair or parents must reside on a dairy farm.

1. Applications are available at the local high schools, Meigs County Extension Office, and online – www.meigs.osu.edu.
 2. Anyone wishing to compete for Prince and Princess must turn in a completed application form and a TYPED essay.
 3. Tentative interview for Royalty will be announced at a later time. Appropriate dress for an interview will be required.
 4. All candidates will be required to participate in the parade on Sunday August 14th, 2011. You must be there at 4:45pm for the parade lineup. Parade begins at 5:15pm. Crowning will follow the parade.
 5. Applications must be received and/or postmarked by **Friday June 8th, 2012 at 5:00pm.** No applications will be accepted after this date and time. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
