

4-H Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

President Carla Hopton called the meeting to order with six advisors, two members and Educator Cassie Turner attending. Kayla Hawthorne led the pledges. The secretary's report was accepted (Alice Hawthorne & Amy Ritchie). The treasurer's report was given and accepted with \$10,720.53 in the treasury (Amy Ritchie & Debbie Finlaw).

Old Business: (1) **Plat book** – The Plat Book Committee voted on Farm & Home Publishers, LTD to print our plat books. A check for \$5000 will be sent for the first installment on the books. The remainder of the balance is to be sent in quarterly installments. (2) **Livestock Skillathons** – The Skillathon Committee had met and determined the three areas of interest for this year would be Skeletal Parts, Retail Cuts of Meat (except for Horses) and the Feed Label. (3) **OVB Scholarship** – Carla announced that Jonathon Barrett won the 2011 Ohio Valley Bank scholarship. Congratulations to Jonathon! (4) **Quality Assurance** – Pre-registration for the make-up Quality Assurance is May 9th. This is the last chance to take Quality Assurance in Meigs County.

New Business: (1) **Livestock Clinic** - Cassie is going to ask John Collins and/or Jonathon Barrett to chair this clinic. (2) **Award's Committee** – Alice Hawthorne volunteered to chair this committee. The committee will meet soon. (3) **Membership Report** – We have 36 clubs, 92 advisors and 518 members. (4) **Reimbursement** - It was agreed to reimburse the Meigs County Extension Office \$600 to cover the cost of office supplies (post cards, postage, etc.) for mailings. (5) **Fundraisers** – Pizza Hut and Bob Evans Family Night fundraisers were discussed. Cassie will check into them.
