Ottawa County 4-H School Enrichment Programs

What are 4-H School Enrichment Programs?



Ohio's 4-H School Enrichment program is dedicated to the delivery of creative and integrated agriculture and life science programming within Ohio's elementary classrooms. Emphasis is placed on helping students become proficient in their understanding of science content and competent in their ability to apply science knowledge in meaningful ways. In addition, Ohio's 4-H School Enrichment curriculum materials are keyed to Ohio's Academic Content Standards and Indicators in all subjects, mainly science. This allows teachers to improve their instruction by expanding their repertoire of highly effective, hands-on activities.

The national 4-H definition of school enrichment is "groups of youth receiving a sequence of learning experiences in cooperation with school officials during school hours, to support the school curriculum." It involves direct teaching by Extension staff or trained volunteers, including classroom teachers. 4-H school enrichment is another way to teach knowledge and skills to youth.

What does 4-H School Enrichment look like in Ottawa County?

This year the Ottawa County 4-H School Enrichment Program has experienced some changes due to the economy. We will still be offering educational programming with a facilitator and kits for grades K-5. Staff from the Ottawa County 4-H Program are available to assist with the programs/kits. After classroom participation in a School Enrichment program students are entitled to the benefits of a 4-H membership for one year. Two of these benefits include the opportunity to attend 4-H Camp and a fair pass for the 2010 Ottawa County Fair!

CHARACTER COUNTS

This three-session character building program is appropriate for any grade level. Students will learn all about respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, trustworthiness, and citizenship. These six pillars of character are highlighted in age appropriate activities and lessons.



Recommended grades: K-5

(3 sessions-45 minutes each)

BUBBLE MANIA

What better way to teach hand-eye coordination and the properties of water than by blowing bubbles? This program includes learning how to make bubbles, visual aids, and playing with bubbles! Please Fall or Spring only.



Recommended Grades: K-2

(1 session-approximately 1 hour)

DIGGING THOSE DINOSAURS

Are you teaching your classroom students about dinosaurs? This program is designed to enhance your classroom curriculum and lessons. This program includes eating like a dinosaur, digging for dinosaurs, and other “dino”-mite activities!



Recommended Grades: K-2

(2 sessions- 45 minutes each)

UNDERGROUND RAILROAD QUILT

A great program to assist in teaching about the Underground Railroad. Students will be able to see miniature quilts made by the 4-H Fashion Board that includes 15 secret signs used on the Underground Railroad. Student will also be able to make their own paper quilt!



Recommended Grades: 2-5

(1 session- 45 minutes)

GONE BUGGIN’

This program will increase the awareness of various creepy crawlies. Students will learn the difference between insects and other arthropods, “see” the world from a bug’s point of view, and much more.



Recommended grades: 3 & 4

(3 sessions - 45 minutes each)

COOL BEANS

Super science with soybeans! Learn the history of soybeans and how they are used in every-day products. Students will learn about water, its properties and other states of matter with the help of soy-related products. Lesson includes hands- on activities. You even get to see real soybeans!



Recommended grades: 3-5

(1 sessions- 45 minutes)

THE INCREDIBLE EGG

Learn about the beginning of life as your class studies chick embryology. This is a four to six week project. Only available March-June. Teachers must be willing to take care of the incubator and eggs during the hatch. Incubators and egg supplies are limited - **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE ONLY.** Teacher driven. **NEW CURRICULUM** for 3rd grade standards. New student work books and teacher guide available for purchase for 3rd grade teachers. FOOD FUN



Children will learn about My Pyramid, play food bingo, enjoy a music CD, read *Eating the Alphabet* - a children's book, experience healthy snack ideas, and understand serving sizes using food models. The kit also contains a teacher's notebook with the *Food Fun* Curriculum.

Recommended Grades: K-2

THE SCIENCE OF SOUND

Students will learn all about sound through experiments, activities, playing music on pipe chimes, coloring their way through a listening skills activity, playing games, learning about *Sounds All Around* - a children's book, and having fun with sound clips on a CD. The kit also contains a teacher's notebook with *The Science of Sound* Curriculum.



Recommended Grades: K-2

ROCKETS AWAY

This project is designed to stimulate interest in math, engineering, aerospace and physics through the exploration of rocketry. Curriculum offers a variety of hands-on experiments and building and launching a 2-liter bottle rocket. Students and/or teachers responsible for providing bottles and 3 cardboard fins. All other materials provided.



Recommended grades: 3 & 4

OUR COUNTRY

This kit will allow children to learn about their country and how to fold a flag, put together a floor puzzle of the United States, learn about the history of the 4-H flag, weave a 4-H flag, sing patriotic songs with a CD, learn fun facts about Ohio and enjoy a children's book entitled *America Is...* The kit also contains a teacher's notebook with the *Our Country* curriculum.



Recommended Grades: K-2

BREADS OF THE HARVEST

This unit focuses on the science and history of bread-making in colonial times. Math, geography, and language skills are incorporated in the lesson plans. A teacher's guide is included. We will provide the materials and curriculum. Staff may assist if requested.



Recommended grades: 3 & 4

GO PLANTS!



This program engages students in the exploration of plant sciences through a variety of science skill-building activities. The unit includes planting, growing and maintaining Wisconsin fast growing plants (approximately one month) under grow

lights. All materials are provided along with a teacher's guide.

Recommended grades: 3 & 4

WEATHER TOGETHER

Students will learn where weather occurs, the water cycle, and different kinds of weather. Includes activities and hands on experiments to re-enforce knowledge about weather.

Recommended grades: 4 & 5

(3 sessions-approximately 45 minutes each)



FITNESS IS FUN

Help children become excited about physical fitness! Share games, snack, activities, songs, and books to promote a better understanding of exercise and how it keeps us healthy. The kit also contains a teacher's notebook with the *Fitness is Fun* curriculum.
