QUALITY ASSURANCE

ALL Jr. Fair Exhibitors with Market livestock projects (Beef, Dairy Beef, Dairy Lactating Cattle, Goats, Dairy Lactating Goats, Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep and Swine) must participate in a Quality Assurance Program in order to show at the Allen County Fair. *There will be no exceptions to this rule.* This year some advisors may be offering this in their clubs, if they attended the advisor training. If your advisor(s) is not offering it in your club then you need to attend our county training offered:

***June 5th, 6pm-7:00pm, in the YAB**

QA TEST OUT OPTION

15-18 year olds have the opportunity to test out of quality assurance. Test out tests are separated into two categories, small animal and large animal, and they are 50 questions long. Youth must receive a 75% on this test to be able to test out. Test outs will be offered **1 HOUR PRIOR** to the regular scheduled Quality Assurance Trainings. We will grade them immediately after, that way if they do not pass they can stay for the training instead of having to come back again. If they pass they will not have to complete quality assurance again.

Policy for receiving premium checks

In order for exhibitors to obtain their checks after the livestock sale they **must** turn thank you letters to their buyers into the Jr Fair office. **Thank you letters should arrive in unsealed, stamped, and addressed envelopes.** You should have a Thank You for each buyer and add-on that you receive. Once the buyers pay they can then pick them up or they will be sent out. **Reminder: If your premium check is over \$600 you have to provide the office with your SSN, before your check will be released. If possible come to the Administration Office and give your SS# to Sue Butcher before August 26th, 2018!**

Food & Nutrition Projects

The Interview Station will provide the participant the opportunity to share their knowledge by answering questions specific to their project book.

The Choose My Plate is an activity that enables the participant the opportunity to demonstrate knowledge learned about My Plate based on information in their book, their 4-H office, or online at www.choosemyplate.gov.

The Portfolio is a project specific to the participant's book and is used to enhance the conversation with the member and a judge about activities the member completed within the project. The participant will be responsible for bringing a 3 pronged folder that includes 8 ½" x 11" pages. The participants will create a maximum of one page (one-sided only) per "activity area" or "interest area" as designated in the front of their project books.

Some ideas for these pages could be a collage, journaling, a timeline, photos taken during their project, or any other format that would illustrate the work and knowledge of the participant. Each page could be different or could be a combination of styles allowing the 4-Her to reflect on their learning experience. There will be no points for scrapbooking style.

The portfolios will be judged on the inclusion of information about the interest or activity areas listed in the front of each book, the organization of the materials, verbal presentation, and communication with the judge regarding their portfolio.

The member will present the portfolio to the judge and have the opportunity to explain each page in their portfolio.

You may have multiple classes for livestock entries (ie. Market and Born and Raised classes). Horse and Pony and Canine need to remember to enter their first animal as class 100 and the second animal as 101 and the third animal as 102 to receive premiums.

Photo Release: You will be asked to fill out a photo release on your exhibitor information. Checking "Yes" means we can use your photos to publish in print, electronic or video format the likeness or image of you/my child. Checking "No" means we cannot use your photo's in print, electronic or video format of you/my child. You also release all claims against the Allen County Agricultural Society and the Jr. Fair Youth Advisors with respect to copyright ownership and publication issues including any claim for compensation related to use of the materials.
