ELIGIBILITY:

1. Student must be an active Allen County Jr. Fair participant and must have exhibited a Jr. Fair project for the past three years.
2. Student must be enrolled (or plans to enroll) full-time at an accredited 4-year college, Jr. College, or 2-year technical school.
3. This scholarship will be awarded only once to an individual.

SELECTION:

1. Written application.
2. Letters of Recommendation – one (1) from each category below
 - A. Jr. Fair (Club or Chapter Advisor or Dept. Superintendent)
 - B. School Official (Teacher, Counselor, Administrator)
 - C. Community (Pastor, Neighbor, Employer)
3. Recent grade transcript
4. Finalists will undergo a personal interview on **Sunday February 17th**. Interviews will be scheduled after the application deadline.
5. Student's academic record, Jr. Fair participation, school activities, and community involvement will be considered in selecting the scholarship winners.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:

\$500 scholarships

Payment will be made to the student upon completion of the first quarter or semester. Student must provide proof that a 2.0 grade point average was maintained.
