# **Allen County Cattlemen's Scholarship**

### **Eligibility:**

- 1. Student must be a son or daughter of a member of the Allen County Cattlemen Association in good standing for the past four years and have carried a cattle (beef or dairy beef) project in 4-H or FFA for at least three years.
- 2. Student must be enrolled (or plans to enroll) full time at an accredited 4-year college, Jr. College, or 2 year technical school.
- 3. Student must have at least one year remaining before graduation from college or technical school.
- 4. Student must complete scholarship application and attach a copy of high school or college (if applicable) grade transcripts.
- 5. Student must carry a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average.
- 6. Student may only receive scholarship twice.
- 7. Student has completed 1 quarter or semester before check will be issued.

#### Selection:

- 1. Written Application
  - a. Resume
  - b. Essay
- 2. Recent grade transcript
- 3. Applicant must exhibit evidence of academic ability and demonstrate leadership ability.
- 4. Selection will be made by the scholarship committee of the Allen County Cattlemen's Association.

#### Scholarship Amount:

- 1. Up to four scholarships for \$500 are available each year.
- 2. Payment will be made to the student's school upon completion of the first semester of college. Students my provide proof that a 2.5 grade point average was maintained.
- 3. Scholarship winners will be recognized at the Cattlemen's Banquet in February.

### Scholarship Deadline:

- 1. The deadline for applying is February 1, 2024
