Eligibility:

1. Age 16-19 as of January 1 of current year. Previous winners are eligible for the same title again. **Youth can only be royalty in one department each year.**
2. Active at least two or more years, including this year, in the Allen County Junior Fair.
3. All applicants and their parents will be invited to the crowning at the Fair Kick Off dinner (compliments of the Allen County Agricultural Society)
4. Mandatory attendance for Opening Ceremony Ribbon Cutting, Allen County Parade, Daily Livestock Judging (Jr. & Sr. Fair), Grandstand Events, Golden Age Day Activities, Youth Day Activities, Both Livestock Auction, Champion of Champion Showmanship, Barn Games, Champion of All Champion Showmanship Contest, and Carcass Show.

1. Written application

 - b. Essay
2. 2 Letters of Recommendation ***Cannot be a relative**
3. Must appear for an interview on Wednesday June 22nd at the Junior Fair Office. No make-up interview will be scheduled. The time for your interview will be determined later. You will be notified by email with your scheduled time.
