

Allen County Agricultural Society Scholarship Ruth Adgate Wagner 4-H Scholarship Allen County Horse Council Scholarship

Eligibility:

1. Student must be an active Allen County Jr. Fair participant and must have exhibited a Jr. Fair project for the past three year.
2. Student must be enrolled (or plans to enroll) full-time at an accredited 4-year college, Jr. College, or 2-year technical school.
3. This scholarship will be awarded only once to an individual.

Selection:

1. Written application
 - a. Resume
 - b. Essay
2. 2 Letters of Recommendation- pick two (2) categories below ***Cannot be a relative**
 - a. Jr. Fair (Club, Chapter Advisor, or Dept. Superintendent)
 - b. School Official (Teacher, Counselor, or Administrator)
 - c. Community (Pastor, Neighbor, or Employer)
3. Recent grade transcript
4. All applicants will undergo a personal interview on **Sunday February 13th, 2022**. Interviews will be scheduled after the application deadline. Contact the office if you do not receive a letter with interview time listed.
5. Student's academic record, Jr. Fair participation, school activities, and community involvement will be considered in selecting the scholarship winners.

Scholarship Amount:

- \$500 Scholarships
- Payment will be made to the student upon completion of the first quarter or semester. Student must provide proof that a 2.0 grade point average was maintained.
- Scholarship winners will be recognized at the Allen County Fair Kick-Off Dinner in August.
